### **New York State Thruway to Exit 17 at Newburgh:**

Take Exit 17 until the toll booth. Just after the toll booth there will be two choices: straight or bear right. Get into the left lane and go straight. The road ends at an intersection with Route 17K and a traffic light. Turn right onto 17K West. Then get into the left lane. After several hundred feet, there is a traffic light. Turn left onto Route 300 South. Go straight on Route 300 South until the road ends at an intersection and a traffic light (approx 2 miles). Turn Left which continues Route 300 South (approx 2 miles). Stay on the main road (after several hundred feet it bends to the right). Just after you pass Blockbuster Video on the left, there is a five-way intersection with a stop light. At the intersection turn right onto Route 94 West. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.

### **Via Route 84 (West or East Bound)**

Take Exit 7S (Route 300 South / Union Ave South / I-87 /Thruway) At end of ramp turn right onto Route 300 South. You'll be on Route 300 South for 4.6 miles. Go straight on Route 300 South until the road ends at an intersection and a traffic light (approx 2 miles). Turn Left which continues Route 300 South (approx 2 miles). Stay on the main road (after several hundred feet it bends to the right). Just after you pass Blockbuster Videos on the left, there is a five-way intersection with a stop light. At the intersection turn right onto Route 94 West. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.

### **\* Scenic route from from I-84 (West Bound)**

Take exit 10S (Route 32 and Route 9W) At end of ramp, turn right and merge onto Route 32. Quickly get into middle lane which will turn RIGHT. At the 9W intersection and traffic light, turn right onto Route 9W south. You will now be in the left lane. In about 100 feet is another traffic light, which to the left is the entrance to the Newburgh Beacon Bridge. DON'T turn left. Stay in this lane through the traffic light, then quickly shift one lane to the left. In about 200 feet is another traffic light. Turn left here onto North Plank Road. This road has many names and you will be on it for 3.9 miles. The names are North Plank Road, North Street, Leroy Place, Water Street, South Water Street, and River Road. The first five are also called Marine Drive. For much of this distance the Hudson River can be seen on the left. When the road becomes Water Street and the railroad tracks are seen on the left all most any left hand turn will take you to one of many excellent restaurants. The restaurants are

right on the river. There are also nice walk ways along the river. Continue on the main road until you cross over Route 9W. This road will bend to the left, BUT YOU WILL GO STRAIGHT onto Blooming Grove Turnpike (for .6 miles). This road ends at a stop sign. Go straight which merges onto Route 94 West. Continue on this road for 1.7 miles. You will see the Vails Gate Fire House on the right, as you approach a five-corners intersection with a traffic light. At this intersection your choices are left, right, and straight. You want to go straight through. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.

#### **From the Palisades Parkway (North Bound):**

Take the Palisades Parkway North until it ends at the Bear Mountain Circle (which is about a hundred feet short of the Bear Mountain Bridge). At the circle, take the third exit for 9W North (DON'T take the second exit for the Bridge). Now follow the directions for 9W North Bound.

#### **Via Route 9W (North bound):**

At Cornwall turn right at the Quaker Ave exit (this is just after the Angola Road exit). At end of the ramp take a left onto Quaker Ave (west). The road ends at an intersection with Route 32 (approx 1/2 mile). Turn right onto Route 32 (north). Go straight on Route 32 for 1.6 miles. You'll approach a five-way intersection with a traffic light. Get into the far left lane. Turn left onto route 94 West. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.

#### **Via Route 9W (South bound):**

You'll go thru the city of Newburgh. You'll pass Gus's Restaurant/Tavern on the right. It's a brick building that faces an intersection with a traffic light. It's on the far right corner. After Gus's, go a few hundred feet to the first traffic light and bear right onto Route 94 West. Continue on this road for 3.4 miles. You will see the Vails Gate Fire House on the right as you approach a five-corners intersection with a traffic light. At this intersection your choices are left, right, and straight ahead. You want to go straight through. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.

#### **Via Route 32 (North)**

Take Route 32 north and you'll pass Cornwall's Quaker Ave intersection. Stay straight on Route 32 for 1.6 more miles. You'll approach a five-way intersection with a traffic light. Get into the far left lane. Turn left onto route 94 West. Go 1.1 miles to the intersection of Mount Airy Road (the road sign is on the right). Turn left into Cornwall Central High School.
